GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF TASK(S) AND OBJECTIVES TO BE ACHIEVED

Background: Under the overall supervision of the Assistant Director General / Regional Representative for Europe and Central Asia (REU), the direct technical supervision of the Forestry Officer (REU), day to day supervision of the National Project Coordinator and in close coordination with GEF National Project Director, the Forest Management Specialist (Vojvodina Region) works in close cooperation with FAO Serbia staff, the international Forest Management Expert, the Forest Management Specialist (Coordinator - Component 2 and Western Serbia), the Forest Biodiversity team and the NFI team as well as other international and national experts as appropriate.

The Forest Management Specialist (Vojvodina Region) will carry out the following tasks:

- In coordination with the International Forest Management Expert and the Forest Management Specialist (Coordinator - Component 2 and Western Serbia), support the preparation guideline documents for sustainable silvicultural practices in different forest types, integrating climate change considerations and biodiversity conservation based on EU habitats directive.
- In coordination with the International Forest Management Expert and the Forest Management Specialist (Coordinator - Component 2 and Western Serbia), support the elaboration of a manual and technical guidelines for forest development and forest management planning integrating Climate Change Mitigation (CCM) and Biodiversity (BD) considerations into Forest Development Plan (FDP) and Forest Management Plan (FMP) procedures.
- In coordination with the International Forest Management Expert and the Forest Management Specialist (Coordinator - Component 2 and Western Serbia), support the elaboration of methodologies for new elements in FDP and FMP such as Forest Function Mapping, Forest Site Mapping and Land Erosion Risk Mapping.
- Contribute to the Elaboration of a new Forest Development Programme and related legislation.
- Perform training needs assessment and design of trainings (including training materials) for SFM for technicians and forest owners.
- Together with International Forest Management Expert conduct training of forest planner and managers.
- Participation in the selection process of pilot FMUs as well as coordinate the related filed activities at the level of forest regions and FMUs and their implementation in Vojvodina Region.
- Establishment of demonstration plots for typical management measures in common forest types in Vojvodina Region.

- Support preparation and participate in workshops for private forest owners on FMP implementation.
- Organization of excursions and Open days of the Forests.
- Perform other duties as required.

The above-mentioned tasks will be performed during the course of the project as appropriate.

Key competencies/qualifications and experience:

- Advanced University degree (preferably PhD) in forest management planning or forest inventory, or other related disciplines;
- At least 8 years of progressively professional experience with forest management planning and implementation, in particular in private forests;
- Experience in the region an advantage;
- Full working knowledge of Serbian;
- Limited working knowledge of English;
- Strong ability to work under pressure and against tight deadlines;
- Strong drafting and interpersonal skills, honesty, orientation on achievements
